I cut pieces of leaves to line my nest in a plant stem. Unlike other bees, I carry yellow pollen under my abdomen, instead of on my back legs.



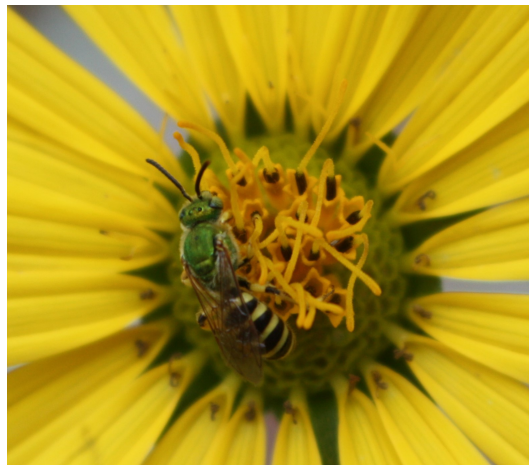
Wool Carder Bee

I line my nest with balls of fuzz that I scrape from leaves. I’m easy to spot because I can hover.



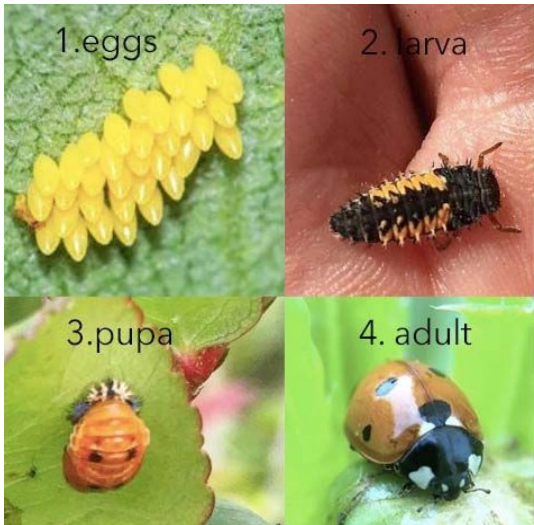
Bi-coloured Green Sweat Bee
